## A Report on NSS Seven Days' Special Camp

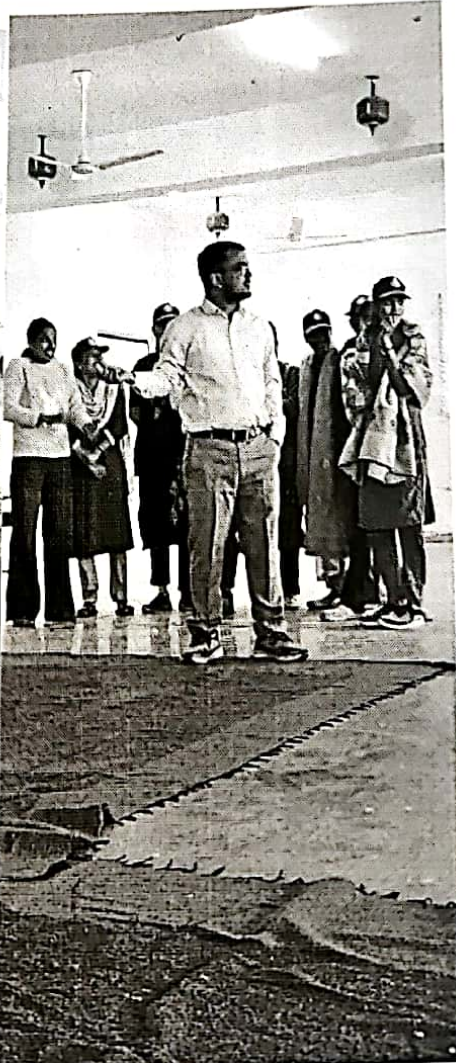
### Day 4<sup>th</sup> (10/02/2026)

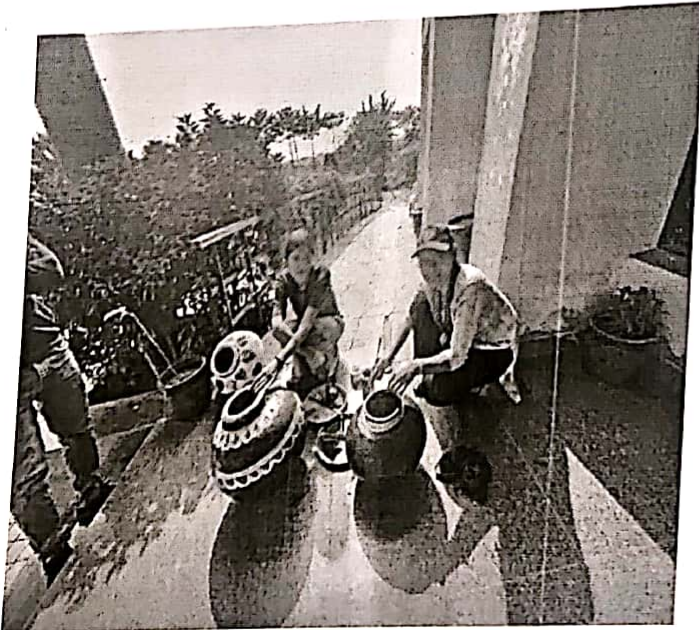

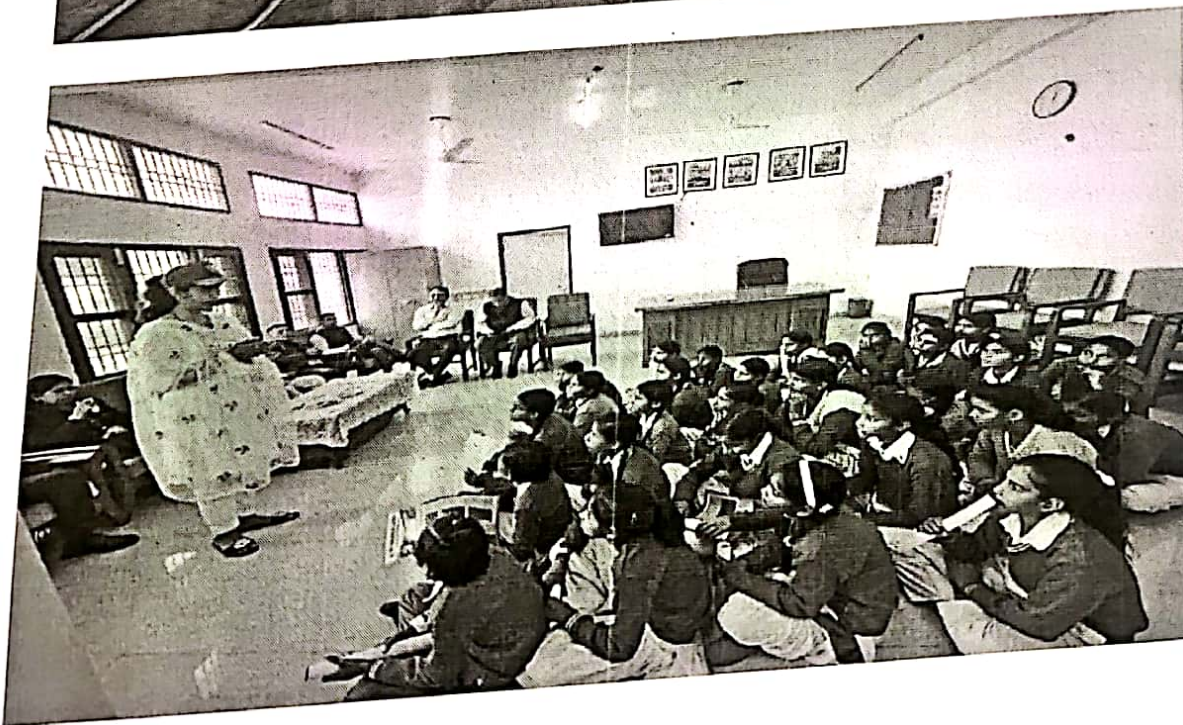

## Day 6<sup>th</sup> (12/02/2026)

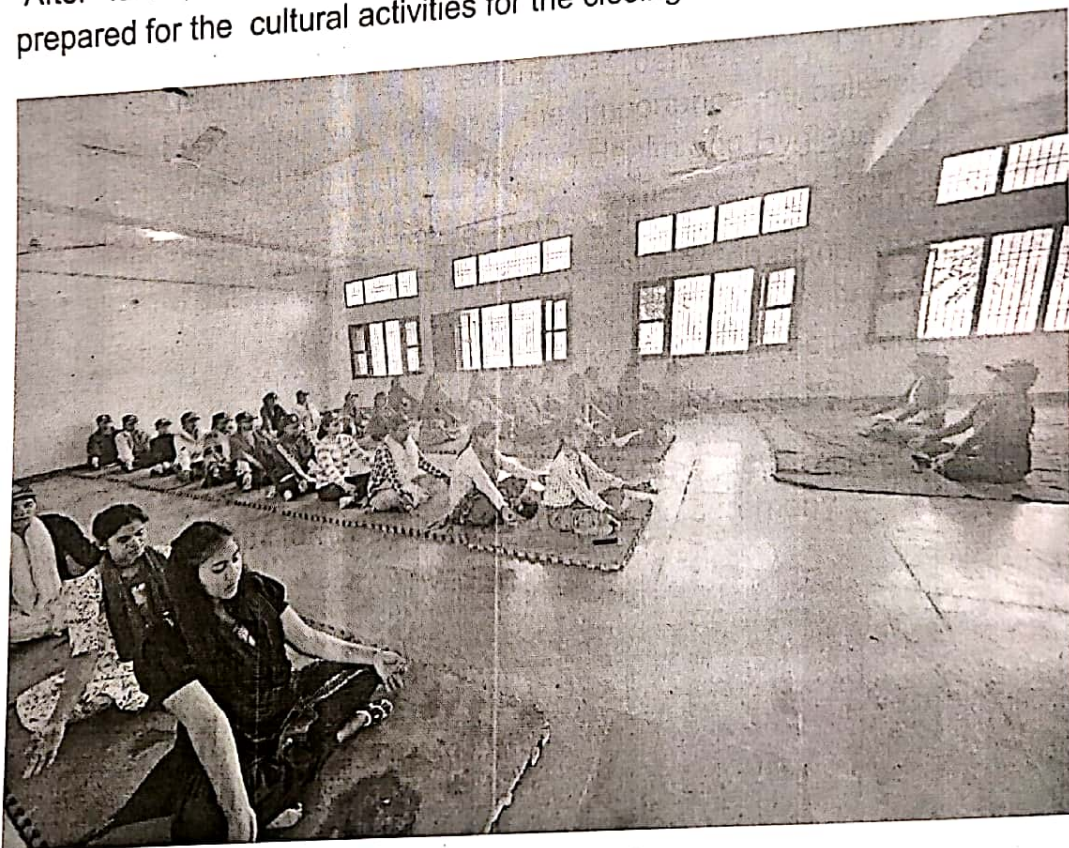

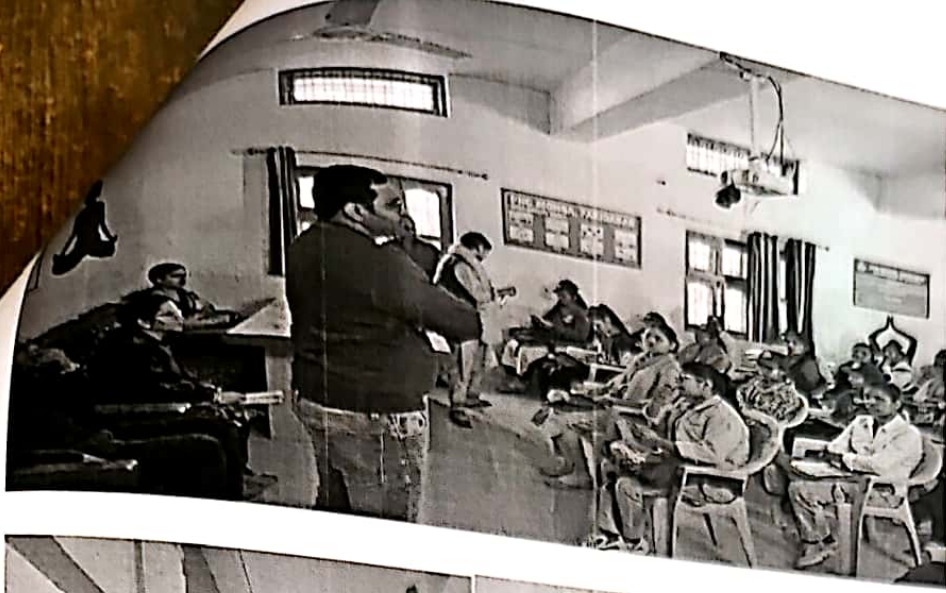
After lunch, students performed the cleaning activity, decoration and prepared for the cultural activities for the closing ceremony.

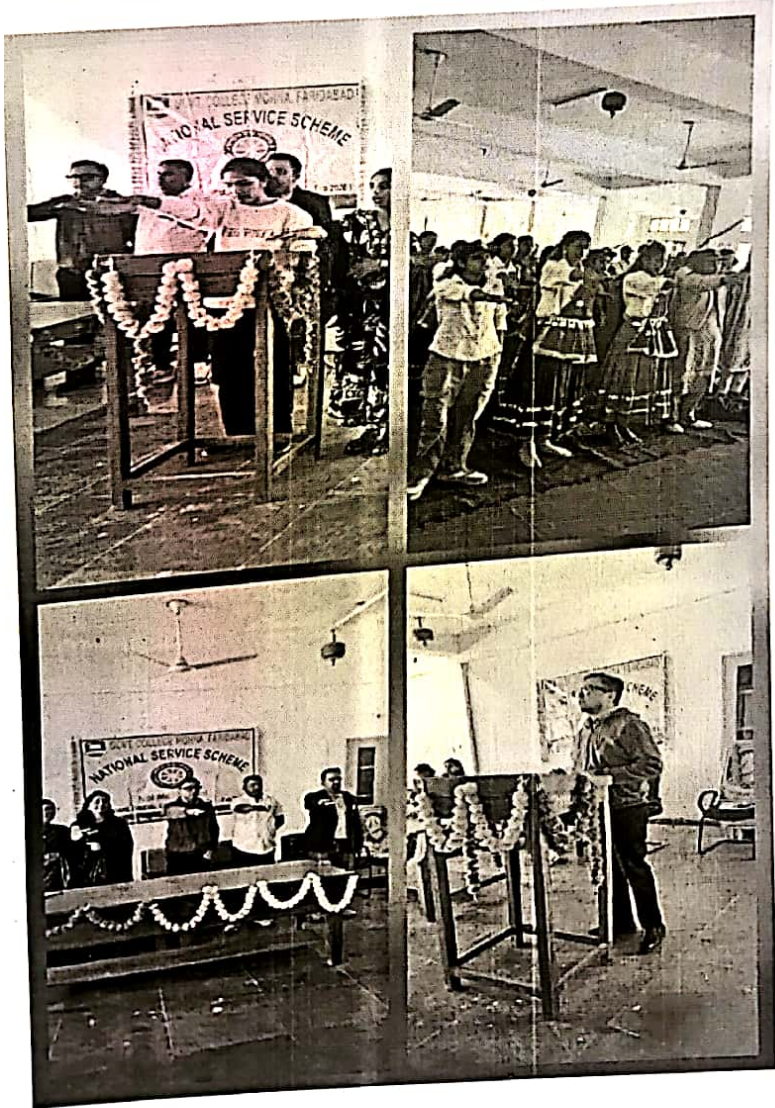
